HOMEWORK

- Unless otherwise indicated on the planner, every assignment will be <u>due the next day</u> or the
 next time the class meets. Usually, a separate homework assignment is not given, but students
 should complete at home what is not completed in class.
- Reading for 20-30 minutes daily is a great homework activity!

CLASS PROCEDURES

- Upon entering the room, students should sit at their assigned seat and get any homework that was assigned the night before, along with their planner.
- Copy the planner information from the board we will have periodic checks
- If you have missed class, check the crate and calendar on the back counter for missing assignments

- You receive 10 bonus points on every test of the 9 weeks
- You lose 2 points any time you leave class
